This class includes topics such as FAA regulations, airspace, weather sources, crew resource management, aeronautical decision making, emergency procedures, and much more.

End the day with testing strategy guidance and review of over 200 practice questions to help prepare you for testing day.

This 2-day onsite course includes one day of Part 107 classroom training. It also includes a second day of hands-on flight training covering skills such as equipment set up, basic flight maneuvers, camera operation, emergency procedures, essential maintenance, preventative measures, troubleshooting, and firmware updates.

This 5-day course will cover everything you need to know to start your police UAS program. The course teaches the most challenging aspects of the FAA's Remote Pilot Written Exam (Part 107), COA rules and regulations, and how to operate a public safety drone program.

Topics covered include the National Airspace System, public aircraft operations, building a UAS program, components of a UAS program, crew resource management, selecting the right equipment, and use cases and missions. The course then transitions to extensive hands-on training to build your drone operator's necessary skills and guides you on methods to integrate drones into your daily field operations for both indoor and outdoor flight.

This course aims to give the student the appropriate tools to recognize signs of aggression and practical tools to de-escalate during law enforcement encounters. The student will come away with practical techniques to prevent aggressive verbal behavior from escalating to a violent physical confrontation.

The role of the manager is often clearly stated but rarely defined. The manager is given the task of guiding subordinates while keeping an organization's goals and objectives. This training seminar will outline what it takes to be an effective manager by building and fostering fundamental leadership principles in the attendee.

This course is designed to give Law Enforcement Officers the tools necessary to improve their speed and accuracy with a duty pistol dramatically. Focused on realism, the class stresses the importance of proper training to increase survivability in high threat situations. This class is not appropriate for beginner level students. Students should be comfortable drawing and firing their pistol in less than 2 seconds at a minimum.

This course builds on the skills and techniques taught during Advanced Pistol 1 by placing students in realistic scenarios where speed, accuracy, and decision making are paramount. Topics covered include: shooting while moving, operating in and around vehicles, use of cover, weapon retention, and much more. Students are required to attend Advanced Pistol 1 before this course.

The course includes safety, fundamental marksmanship, carry methods, weapon manipulation, shooting positions, and basic introductory rifle shooting drills. The course is designed for the entry-level carbine shooter.

Introduction to advanced shooting positions. The student will be introduced to tactical doctrine stressing the components of the present 360 mindsets. The student will develop the necessary skills needed to survive in an urban combat setting. The student will learn the effective use of cover and concealment, tactical reloads, equipment positioning, and shooting from different shooting positions that are often encountered on the modern battlefield.



Introduction to urban combat drills, stress-induced sensory overload to simulate a combat environment, the advanced rifle will incorporate all of the lessons from Basic Rifle and Intermediate Rifle courses. The skillset developed from the previous courses will be utilized every day of the advanced class. The student will use the skillsets developed as each day progresses. The student will be challenged with tactical decisions that are often encountered in urban terrains. Physically demanding.



Students will receive the skillset that is necessary to develop a combat mindset. On day one, the student will participate in a review of individual students' weapon handling skills. Each day will build upon the lessons learned the previous day. As each day progresses, the training regimen difficulty increases.

This course is designed for the shooter who makes use of an optical shooting device for their firearm. Students will be taught installation, battle sight zero, the effect of the height difference from the mounting of the optic, and its relationship to the weapon system's actual barrel. The student will then incorporate these lessons and use this information for shot placement at known distances and employ proper "hold" at CQB distances and beyond.

The course culminates on day two with a field exercise where the students will be required to use the tactics and tradecraft to conduct a covert surveillance mission practical training in the field. The students will have to utilize each of the tradecraft specialties that were taught during the lecture format.

This is the first course in our criminal intelligence series. Conducting illegal intelligence operations allows you to get ahead of emerging criminal trends and are an absolute necessity when facing the potential of civil unrest or mass protests. We will provide the necessary skill sets needed to conduct illegal intelligence operations properly so that you can produce an actionable product for the end-user.

This course will provide the student with the fundamental skills necessary to use open-source intelligence data as a useful tool for criminal investigations and to police. Upon course completion, the student will have the ability to maximize their investigative efforts through effective information gathering and data point exploration and exploitation. The course culminates on day two with a field exercise where the participants will be required to demonstrate their ability to use open-source information in a real-world field exercise effectively.

Our Counter Surveillance and Surveillance Detection course is a two-day training evolution. We place a heavy emphasis on practical application. We believe that learning occurs when an emotional/and or physical response is elicited from the student, and we have found throughout our careers that sitting through hours of PowerPoint presentations does not necessarily make for a good learning experience.
