Skyfire's 4-day SWAT Tactics training course developed and instructed by Mike Rogers, Director of Public Safety and former FBI UAS Program Manager. The course guides pilots through SWAT specific applications of UAS technology through classroom and hands-on scenario based training.

The classroom portion covers multiple topics from basic program concepts, equipment suggestions and settings, communication methods, tactics, payloads, FAA regulations, confined space, night operations, and blue force options.

Scenarios are crafted to prepare students for a variety of tactical situations and feature indoor and outdoor flying, flying in GPS denied spaces, overwatch, reconnaissance, night operations, group discussions and debriefs following each exercise. The course also covers overall SWAT best practices and considerations.

Scenario #1

Indoor objectives: Flying from stack to entry point, clear initial threats, object avoidance, camera philosophy, UAV placement, object identification, callouts, communication.subheading

Scenario #2

Indoor objectives: Breaching/entry methods, operation locations, flight time considerations, movement masking.

Scenario #3

Outdoor objectives: Obstacles/airspace, lighting, concealed launches, terrain masking, structure overviews, detect threats, overwatch.

Scenario #4

Outdoor objectives: Open area searches, sniper coverage, "squirter" coverage, team directions, confined space searches.
